# SANTORINI WHITES

There are few wines in the world as idiosyncratic as the wines of Santorini. A place marked by a dramatic history - one of the largest volcanic eruptions in human civilization - it only makes sense that the wines hailing from this island are as legendary as Greek mythology itself. Intensely rich with oceanic sea breeze and bright, citrus fruits, these wines are as transparent to their terroir as the clear, blue Aegean Sea. Hatzidakis, Sigalas - these names ring as true to us at Andros Taverna as the stories of Apollo and Poseidon themselves.

Viticulture and wine-making on Crete have a long storied history. During the Minoan civilization, it was one of the first cultural centers to have a true, as we would say today, “wine scene.” The earliest evidence of viticulture on the island dates back to as far as 5000 B.C.! Today, Crete is exploring a viticultural renaissance, championing its native grapes. For whites, Vidiano excites us most for its energy and intense peach and apricot flavors.

While primarily known for the incredible red wines produced in the region, we wanted to let our guests in on a little known secret - the white wines of Macedonia provide some of the most exciting value in the country. Blends of Assyrtiko and Malagousia provide a thrilling, perfumed contrast to the salty, electric Assyrtiko of Santorini. Not to be missed from this region is one of our favorite wines we have available, the totally unique Thymiopoulos “ATMA,” a white wine blend of Malagousia and juice from Macedonia's most famous red grape, Xinomavro.

# MACEDONIA RED

While we love the white wines that come from Macedonia, there is no denying how special the reds are from the region. Macedonia provides an ideal climate for growing many varieties, including international favorites such as Cabernet Sauvignon. Undoubtedly, our favorite comes from the rolling hills of Naoussa and its native grape Xinomavro, inspiring similarities to that of Italy's legendary Barolo. Pro-tip: a bottle of Tatsis "Old Roots" is not to be missed with any of our lamb dishes.

# PELOPONNESSE RED

It almost feels ironic that Agiorgitiko, arguably Greece's most powerful and intense native variety, finds its home in the same region as the mighty city-state of Sparta. Agiorgitiko finds its throne in the appellation of Nemea, where it is either bottled on its own or with international varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon to produce luscious red blends. We would be remiss if we didn't highlight any of the wines from Skouras, one of the region's pioneers and a favorite of the team at Andros Taverna.

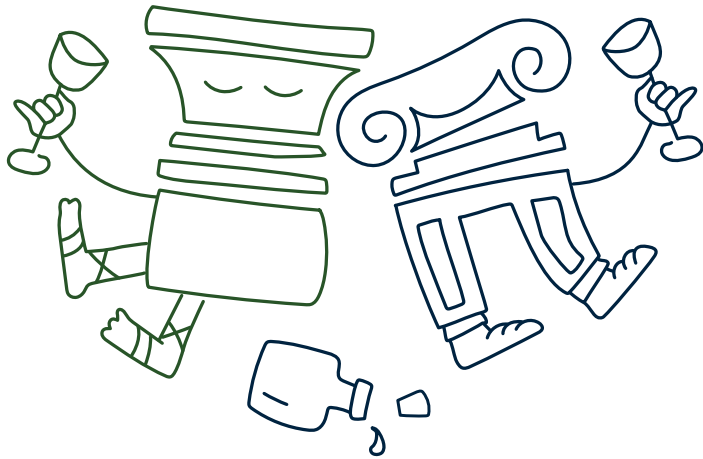
